## WHAT IS CONFLICT MAPPING?

Conflict mapping is an early, dispute-resolution tool designed to assist disputants in a basic understanding of the nature of the conflict, the underlying root causes, situational dynamics involved, and potential outcomes. This visual, mapping tool builds language and capacity for addressing the conflict and engages a plan to limit collateral damage during the conciliation process. The speaker will demonstrate how to use the conflict-mapping techniques that help prepare parties to consider and talk about positions, interests, and options.
